FACTORY DEFAULT VALUES

-Factory's master code: 5-digit 12345 -Relay time delay 1 and 2: 1 second

NOTE: if the red LED blinks a wrong data was entered in programming mode.

SETTING A MASTER CODE

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Enter the default master code twice, the red LED lights on.



Enter 60, then the 5-digit new master code (0 to 9 * and #), the red LED lights off during 1 second.

WARNING: Do not use the master code as a user code. The code 00000 is reserved to delete a user code.

• To exit from the programming mode, press the # key, the red LED lights off.

SETTING USER CODES

Group 1 (relay 1 red LED) User number

Group 2 (relay 2 green led) User number

Enter the master code twice, the red LED lights on.

Enter the user number for group 1: 00 to 29 and for group 2: 30 to 49



Enter the 5-digit user code (0 to 9 * and #), the red LED lights off during 1 second



Repeat the previous steps to enter the next user code.

NB A user code can be programmed in both groups to control simultaneously both relays and with different time delay

Enter the master code twice, the red LED lights on.

Enter 51 for relay 1

Enter 52 for relay 2


According to the selected mode, enter for each relay 1 and relay 2

- 00 for a latched output (NOTE: Do not used the latched output in 24V)
- 01 to 99 for a momentary output

The red LED lights off during 1 second

• To exit from the programming mode, press the # key, the red LED lights off.

CANCELLING A USER CODE





•To exit the programming mode, press the # key, the red LED lights off.

RESETTING THE MASTER CODE

Master code: 12345

Note: User codes are still memorized






After 10 seconds, the red LED lights on during 1 second, put back the jumper on 2 and 3, the master code has been reset to the factory default value.

WARNING: This product operates in $12V = /\sim$ (the wire is not cut). Cut the wire to operate the keypad in $24V = /\sim$.

OPERATING MODE



As soon as a code is recognized, it activates the corresponding relay.

NOTE:

The 0 digit can be used as an external push button when a clock timer is connected. When the timer is on, pressing on 0 will activate relay 1. Use relay 2 for another control, for example an alarm.




Wiring diagram




